Specific Needs


This section of your prayer guide lists needs that you "see" as you prayer walk on the campus and needs you might "hear about" from staff, students or others. What can I do about these needs?

Our Prayer-Walking Guide

In The Parking Lot

*As you drive onto the campus, ask God to watch over our bus drivers, car riders and every vehicle that delivers people to the school. As people enter the buildings, this year they will go through a temperature check. Pray that everyone will be gracious and courteous in this process.

At the Front Entrance

*Pause for a moment and ask God to keep everyone safe who enters this building. Ask Him to give special focus to the School Resource Officer(s) (SRO) to be a hedge of protection for the physical safety of every student and person on the campus.

Cafeteria & Custodians

*Somewhere close by is a cafeteria with employees given the responsibility of preparing healthy meals in a safe environment, keeping the facilities clean and delivering meals via new procedures. They must walk through the hallways that are kept clean by a custodial and maintenance staff that are often unnoticed. Every hallway, classroom, restroom, workroom and surface must be kept clean; imagine the importance of these tasks as you pray for these staff members.

School Nurse & Clinic

*In this year of medical uncertainty, somewhere in the school is a nurse who will be at the center of every medical question. The nurses will be responsible to give care, diagnosis, counsel and advice to the schools administrators and families. Pray that God will give them physical protection and great wisdom as they care for our students.

Administrators & Office Staff

*Please pray for our Principal and Assistant Principal. In addition to their usual duties and responsibilities, this year they must deal with the unknown issues of our current pandemic. They must consider the safety of every student, teacher, staff member and family along with providing the supervision required to achieve excellence in academics. They must deal with different voices, opinions, difficult situations along with school boards and governmental authorities. Pray for wisdom, a firm commitment, and a gentle caring spirit.

Grade Level and Special Position Teachers

*Our teachers are facing challenges like never before. Some families will choose to keep their children at home and practice "distance learning" where teachers will be required to teach via the internet.
